

How to get to Bruker AXS



Bruker AXS Delft can be easily reached from Schiphol airport, either by train, by taxi or by car.

Once in Delft, the Delft hotels are easy to find.

Delft is located south of Amsterdam and Schiphol, between The Hague (Den Haag) en Rotterdam.

Travel by train

The fastest and most economical transport from Schiphol airport to Delft is by train: Less than 45 minutes.

The Schiphol railway station is situated under the Airport Arrival hall. The platform direction Den Haag/ Rotterdam is accessible from within the arrival hall by an escalator. Do NOT take the direction Amsterdam.

The fare to Delft is 7.00 Euro second class (Price levels May 2002). The trains run at least twice per hour. Change trains in Leiden or in Den Haag HS. The time tables and tracks are synchronised, so changing is easy (same platform).

We advise one of the following trains:

From the railway station one can take a taxi to Bruker AXS (10 minutes). The address is: Bruker AXS, Oostsingel 209.

From the railway station you can also take the tram (10 minutes) to Bruker AXS. You can buy a ticket on the tram, but if you are staying longer it is cheaper to buy multiple tickets, a so-called "strippenkaart", in advance at the station.

The tram stop is near the station, over the bridge on the left hand side. Take tramline 1 in direction Den Haag (The Hague) and get out at the stop "Brasserskade". From there you can walk west to the Curacaostraat and follow this street south until you hit the waterfront (Oostsingel 209). There is the entrance of the Bruker AXS office.

It is also possible to walk from the railway station. This takes approximately 15-20 minutes.

Go to the front of the station. Cross the bridge and turn left in north-north-western direction.

Walk on, parallel to the railway. You will pass a (small) part of the old city walls of Delft and a mill.

Walk on, follow the tram tracks, pass a brown brick building called Bacinol on your left hand, go in the direction of a watertower, follow the road, past a large house with pillars on your right hand and go in the direction of the bridge.

Cross the bridge and then go to the building which is on the other side of the bridge, directly below on your left hand side.

You can either take the adventurous road through the shrubbery or walk on to the traffic lights and then go back along Curacaostraat until you hit the waterfront. There you can enter the Bruker AXS office.



Travel from Schiphol by taxi

Going from Schiphol to Delft by taxi is rather expensive. It is advised to arrange a price beforehand. 75 Euro is a good deal.

Travel by car

Traffic jams permitted, (especially around 9 a.m and 5 p.m) driving from Schiphol to Delft takes 45 minutes.

- From Schiphol airport take the highway (A4) to Den Haag (The Hague).
- Near Den Haag at a large multilevel traffic junction take the E19/A13 direction Delft, Rotterdam.
- Take the 1st motor way exit (exit 8) to Delft. This is called Delft-Noord.
 - Follow the directions Delft Center.
 - You will arrive at a T-crossing with a tramway, turn left.
 - Next traffic light straight on.
 - Keep to the right and just before the next traffic light leave the road and turn on to the road parallel to the main road.
 - Follow this road until you see the water side.

The Bruker AXS building is at this corner. The main entrance is also near this same corner. The best place to park is on the parallel road you have just followed.
